## **DESCRIPTION**

This variety is very interesting for its earliness, size, colour, and eating quality.

The plant has good vigour, abundant flowering and bears fruit on all types of branches. The fruit remain on the tree for a long time.

FRUIT: it has oval or elongated-shaped fruits (size AA - AAA, average weight 105 g). The skin is orange with a slight red shading on sunny side. The flesh is orange and consistent; it has a balanced and aromatic taste, as well as excellent organoleptic qualities.
