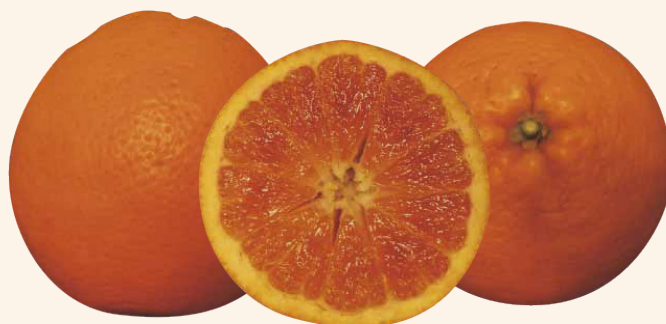

### ORIGIN

Tarocco "Degenerazione delle Vescichette" variety was selected at the CRA-Istituto Sperimentale per l'Agrumicoltura of Acireale in 1976. The variety from which it originated is a negative mutation of the common Tarocco blood orange, which produces fruit with vesicles with a very low juice content. Nucellar propagation eliminated the negative characteristics of the original variety, replacing them with completely new positive ones.

### SINTHETIC CONSIDERATION

This variety is known for its extremely early ripening period, its intense flesh anthocyanin pigmentation, the high fruit size and good organoleptic qualities..
