

ORIGIN Tarocco "Degenerazione delle Vescichette" variety was selected at the CRA-Istituto Sperimentale per l'Agrumicoltura of Acireale in 1976. The variety from which it originated is a negative mutation of the								

l'Agrumicoltura of Acireale in 1976. The variety from which it originated is a negative mutation of the common Tarocco blood orange, which produces fruit with vesicles with a very low juice content. Nucellar propagation eliminated the negative characteristics of the original variety, replacing them with completely new positive ones.

SINTHETIC CONSIDERATION

This variety is known for its extremely early ripening period, its intense flesh anthocyanin pigmentation, the high fruit size and good organoleptic qualities.
